

What is the PRCS General Assembly?

PRCS General Assembly is the highest Platform according to PRCS Constitution. It is held once every 4 years, and it brings together all PRCS members from Palestine and the Diaspora (including Executive Board Members, Administrative Council Members, and Representatives from more than 35 branches and sub-branches, as well as observer members), with a participation of PRCS partners, from Local Authorities, Red Cross and Red Crescent Partners, and National and International Agencies, among others.

The General Assembly serves as a main tool for accountability and ensuring engagement of the various stakeholders. Endorsing the New Strategy, Presenting Reports, as well as the elections of the President and the Executive Board and Administrative Council are part of the main outcomes of the General Assembly.
