Overview of the PRCS Gaza Strip Branches 1\7\2024 - 10\7\2024

RAFAH GOVERNORATE

- PRCS branch and its facilities are not functional since mid May after the ground military opetation.
- EMS teams have been reallocated in two locations: one inside the ICRC field hospital and the second inside the UK field hospital.
- All PRCS medical points (Al Nasr, Al Attar, Park, Tel Al Sultan medical points) in Rafah were closed after the ground military operation in May.
- 2 PRCS IDPs camps are still in Al Mawasi Rafah (North West al Mawasi).
- Aid consignments are halted due to the closure of the Rafah crossing by the occupation.

Khan Younis Governorate

The PRCS has restored operations in most of the departments at Al Amal Hospital. The medical teams have started doing surgeries.

Services provided in the governorate:

- EMS services center (reopened on 19\5\2024)
- 12 IDP camps.
- 3 Primary health care centers
- 2 Medical points
- 2 Field hospitals
- Relief assistance distribution disrupted due to Rafah closure

Central Governorate

Services provided in the governorate:

- EMS services
- Relief services disrupted due to Rafah closure
- PHC services are provided in Deir Al Balah clinic
- 30 displaced families are housed at the branch.
- 2 IDP camps
- 3 new IDPs camps are being set up.
- 5 Medical points

GAZA GOVERNORATE

• The PRCS team is evaluating the condition in the branch of Gaza and its facilities to set a plan for resuming work and reopenieng AlQuds Hospital & other facilities which have been non functional since 14/11/2023.

NORTH GAZA GOVERNORATE

- The PRCS is in the process of reopening its North Gaza Branch & EMS center to resume its humanitarian operation from there,
- PRCS Advanced Medical Post (AMP) in Jabalia resumed the provision of its services after being halted due to the heavy shelling in the region.

The PRCS provides EMS services to Palestinians in Gaza and North Gaza governorates since the 27th of May through:

- 5 ambulances
- 13 EMTs
- 12 volunteers (First responders).

Humanitarian Intervention in the Gaza Strip

22,308 injured persons received first aid services & **7,071** fatalities were evacuated by PRCS teams. In addition, the teams provided emergency medical services to additional 50,148 emergency medical cases.



345,990 individuals benefiting from community health services & health awareness activities. They organized 117,148 activities benefiting 228,842 individuals.



94,821 individuals benefiting from psycho social support activities.



4,150 individuals benefiting from rehabilitation services, 600 received assistive devices.

These services are being offered across the displacement camps established by PRCS, at their medical posts, as well as in shelters managed by UNRWA.

Medical Posts & Clinics



- In Gaza governorate, last week of June, 3 medical points (Al Shujaiya, Al Sabra, and Al Sahaba) were opened to provide medical services to thousands of Palestinians. Unfortunately, on 8 July, these three medical points were taken out of service due to the Israeli occupation forcible evacuation orders in certain neighborhoods in the governorate.
- In North Gaza governorate, Jabalia advanced medical post is functional providing medical services.
- In Central governorate, PRCS runs one clinic and 5 medical points (Al Nuseirat Medical Point, Al Basah Medical Point, Al Zawayda Medical Point, Al Sawarha Medical Point and Bureij Medical Point).
- In Khan Younis governorate, PRCS runs 3 clinics (Al Amal, Al Mawasi and Ma'an clinics) and 2 medical points (Al Qararah Medical Point and Bani Suheila Medical Point).
- In Rafaha governorate, all medical points were all closed after the Israeli ground military operation started in May.

As of 10\7\2024, estimated number of beneficiaries is 371,360.

Field Hospitals in Khan Younis

 Al Quds medical post: it was moved to Al Mawasi region in Khan Younis where thousands of Palestinians are displaced from Rafah after the ground military operation. The medical services in the medical post were reinforced to become a field hospital with the capacity of 24 beds to serve the residents and displaced in the governorate. The field hospital provide all medical services except for X-ray and specialized surgeries which are referred to PRCS Al Amal hospital.

 Al Kuwaiti field hospital: it is being installed in Khan Younis city in Al Amal neighbourhood with the capacity of 32 beds. It is fully equiped and supported by the Kuwaiti RC.

Humanitarian interventions in the Gaza Strip from 7\10\2023 to 10\7\2024



The PRCS runs 16 IDPs camps.

- The PRCS IDPs camps are being reallocated in new areas due to heavy bombardment mainly across the Southern Gaza Strip.
- The PRCS is setting up additional 3 IDPs camps in the Central Governorate.
- Rafah Governorate: <u>2 IDPs camps</u> shelter **139 families** (802 persons)
- Deir Al Balah Governorate: 2 IDPs camps shelter 113 families (759 persons)
- Khan Younis Governorate: 12 IDPs camps shelter 1084 families (5647 persons)

Relief Items Distribution

The distribution of relief Items has been disrupted since 7\5\2024 due to the closure of Rafah crossing which is the primary point for entry of humanitarian aids into the Gaza Strip.

Entry of humanitarian aid to the North of the Gaza Strip is done through the Jordan Corridor in coordination with the Jordanian Red Cresecnt Society.

Entry of humanitarian aid through Karem Abu Salem crossing is not easy and not enough due to Israeli restrictions, delays at checkpoints, destroyed roads, unexploded ordnance and fuel shortages.

Relief Items Distribution



- As of October 2023, up until the current reporting period, the relief assistance has reached an estimated (295,726) families, consisting of (1,812,228) individuals, across the Gaza Strip including PRCS IDPs camps &facilities and UNRWA-affiliated shelters.
- Relief assistance includes distribution of food parcels, hygiene kits, blankets, mattresses, water jerry cans, kitchen kits and other necessities

Humanitarian intervention in the West Bank from 1\7\2024 - 10\7\2024

Throughout this period, PRCS responded to (6) fatalities, and provided emergency medical services to **(85)** injured persons distributed as follows:





Relief Assistance:

• Duma village - Nablus Governorate:

Following the Israeli forces' demolition of one house on the 3rd of July, the PRCS, in cooperation with the ICRC, conducted rapid assessment for three families comprising of 17 who received relief assistance including hygiene kits, dignity kits, blankets, mattresses and tarps.

Khirbit Tana Community - Nablus Governorate:

Following the Israeli forces' demolition of 3 residential structure on the 3rd of July, the PRCS, in cooperation with the ICRC, conducted rapid assessment for three families comprising of 17 who received relief assistance including hygiene kits, dignity kits, blankets, mattresses and tarps.

Al Nasariah village - Nablus Governorate:

Following the settlers' raid on the village on the 8th of July, the PRCS, in cooperation with the ICRC, conducted rapid assessment for one family comprising of 5 members whose house was partially burned. The affected family received relief assistance including hygiene kits, dignity kits, blankets, jerry cans, kitchen kit, mattresses and tarps.

Violations against PRCS medical mission in the oPt: 7\10\2023 - 10\7\2024

The deliberate targeting of PRCS's medical mission represents a grave infringement of International Humanitarian Law, (IHL) notably violating the Geneva Conventions

- The appeal sought \$ 298,736,550 in funds from partners and supporters within the international Movement of the RCRC, non movement as well as local & international entities.
- As of 10\3\2024, contributions from a variety of national societies, international organizations, and the private sector have fulfilled 20% of the requested cash funds.
